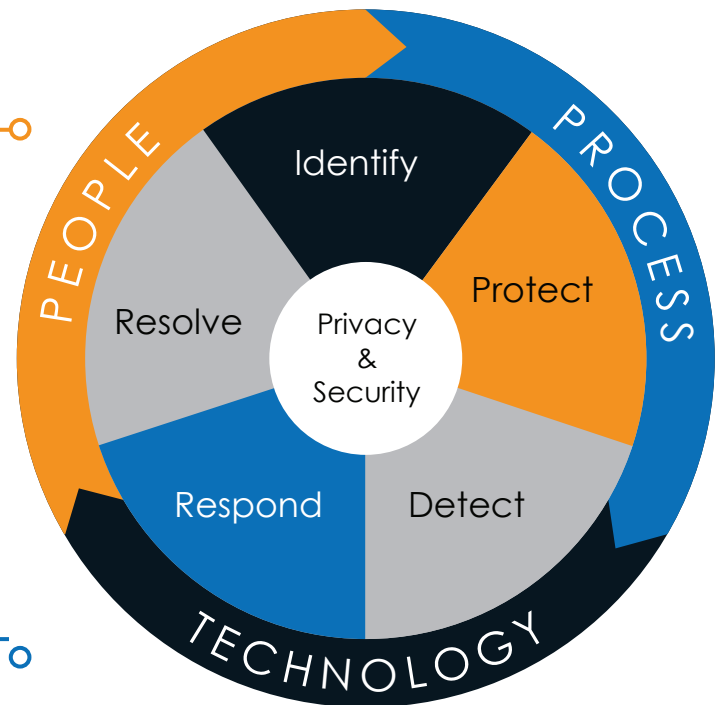
## People:
